

# URBAN FOREST STREET TREE COORDINATOR JOB DESCRIPTION

#### **Reporting to: Urban Forest and Operations Manager**

Trees for Cities have a strong track record of delivering high quality and bespoke urban tree planting projects and edible playgrounds.

Our London and regional urban forest programme is a core focus for the charity. In London we now plant up to 25,000 trees each year through a programme of urban tree planting projects including; street trees, orchards, woodland creations, parks, open green spaces, estates and school projects.

We are looking for an experienced, highly driven and skilled individual to join the team to deliver and drive forward the urban forest street tree programme. The successful candidate will hold a nationally recognised qualification in either urban forestry or arboriculture and have experience of project managing delivery and management of urban tree planting projects.

#### WHAT YOU'LL DELIVER

- Project manage a programme of urban street tree projects ensuring they are delivered safely in line with current health and safety practices to a high quality finish with an excellent level of customer service and value for money
- Act as the main point of contact for local authorities, tree officers, project partners, housing associations, schools and community groups to manage clear lines of
- Work with local authorities, Tree officers, project partners, housing associations, schools and community groups to secure appropriate tree planting locations
- Undertake site surveys and collect all supporting data required to produce well thought through and considered feasibility reports and plans to inform and drive forward planting strategies
- Source statutory services plans and work directly with consultants and contractors to undertake statutory service surveys on all street tree projects to inform tree planting locations
- Work with the Community Education and Volunteer Manager to agree plans for community engagement, developing informative materials to consult, inform and engage the local community
- Work with the Urban Forest Manager to produce recommended tree species lists from site surveys
- Build good relationships with established tree nurseries, select, source and order all trees and planting accessories, manage deliveries and care of tree stock

- Manage budgets for tree planting projects, monitor and forecast project spend to keep spend within budget and produce financial reports
- Work with the Community Education and Volunteering Manager to organise and deliver tree planting ceremonies, promoting and publicising the events to ensure a high level of participation, including designing and disseminating publicity materials to local communities, businesses, funders, VIPs, other stakeholders and schools and liaising with Marketing & Communications Team for pre- and post-event press
- Manage all health and safety for the street tree programme, keeping up to date with current health and safety legislation and best practice guidelines
- Undertake all contract documentation and specifications for delivery of standard tree planting programme, working directly with sub contractors to deliver the works programme.
- Undertake quality control and ensure works are delivered to agreed specifications and best practices, signing off works as completed
- Monitor and evaluate the delivery and impact of the tree planting programme
- Manage a three year maintenance programme to ensure successful establishment and monitor tree health
- Manage tree database, keeping records up to date

- High quality street tree planting projects are delivered with good attention to detail, to a scheduled timeframe, within specified budget, and achieve project-specific social and environmental objectives
- Maintaining good partnerships with positive feedback from local councils, projects partners and other stakeholders on the planning and communication of the project

- Safe working practices effectively implemented and high safety record maintained on site

- Undertake all health and safety management and contract documentation
- Produce policies, procedures, risk assessments, method statements, COSHH, and ensure that safe working practices are in line with current legislation and are implemented on site and at the operations base at Ruskin Park
