

TREE PLANTING EVENT AT LONGSTONE AVENUE OPEN SPACE SATURDAY 15TH FEBRUARY 2025 10AM - 2PM

EVENT DETAILS

Please arrive from **10am** and head to the Trees for Cities marquees and registration area. **All participants must sign-in at the registration table before starting the activity.**

Activity: We will be planting young trees in areas with potentially uneven, muddy ground. This activity can involve digging, using a wheelbarrow and hand tools, as well as some lifting.

Background: Trees for Cities and Brent Council are working with local residents to increase planting in Longstone Avenue Open Space, including new hedges and trees. This forms part of the delivery of the Church End and Roundwood Green Corridors, and builds on the recently planted community orchard in the space.

Trees for Cities will provide: Tools, supervision and training, free lunch and refreshments.

Facilities: There will be toilets (portaloos), handwashing stations, and drinking water on site.

Longstone Avenue Open Space is a 20 minute walk from Harlesden station (Lioness/Overground, Bakerloo), Willesden Junction station (Lioness/Overground, Mildmay/Overground, Bakerloo) and Dollis Hill station (Jubilee).

Closest bus stops are St Mary's Road (18, 260, 266) and Roundwood Park (206, 226) - both a 12 minute walk.

Closest train station is Stonebridge Park, 30 minutes by public transport from the event location (Bus 18).

The space can be accessed from Fry Road or Longstone Avenue. Please note there is limited parking nearby.

We encourage all visitors to walk, cycle or take public transport to the site. If you have any questions about accessing the site, please contact the number provided.
