## **PROPAGATING STRAWBERRY RUNNERS**

**Find a new plant:** from June/July the mother plant will produce long shoots called runners, which have little plants attached. Some could be producing roots already.



**Keep the new plant attached:** to the mother plant so it has a supply of water and nutrients.



**Make room for the new plant:** dig a hole away from the mother plant large enough to fit a 9cm pot in. Place pot in hole and fill it with soil.



**Plant the new plant:** pin it to the surface to anchor it in place.



Wait for it to root: the new plant will send roots into the soil and grow in the pot.



**Keep watering:** as it is growing in a pot it will need regular watering until the roots have developed.



**Cut the runner:** once it has rooted (4-6 weeks), cut the new plant from the mother plant.



**Replant:** you can either replant it into the soil or keep it in the pot.
