TREE PLANTING EVENT AT MANORWAY PARK

SATURDAY 6TH DECEMBER

EVENT DETAILS

Please arrive from **10am** and head to the Trees for Cities marquees and registration area. **All participants must sign-in at the registration table before starting the activity.**

Activity: We will be planting young trees in areas with potentially uneven, muddy ground. This activity can involve digging and lifting as well as using simple hand tools and wheelbarrows.

Background: This planting day is part of a larger project to plant more trees in Thamesmead and contribute to increasing species and age diversity and climate resilience. The new trees will provide visual interest for park users, as well as increase biodiversity and bring benefits to wildlife in the area.

Trees for Cities will provide: Tools, supervision and training, free lunch and refreshments.

Facilities: There will be toilets (portaloos), handwashing stations, and drinking water on site.

Manorway Park is in North Thamesmead. It is a 30 minute walk or 20 minutes with public bus from Abbey Wood station.

Closest bus routes are 401 and 177. The 244, 229 and 301 run past Abbey Wood station.

Closest train station is Abbey Wood.

The park can be accessed from Greenhaven Drive, Copperfield Road, Crossway and the Thames Path.
