



Overview: The aim of the game is to learn about the edible parts of vegetables, fruits and flowers. You need to decide the name of each plant, what part of it we eat, how to describe this part and suggest examples of similar crops.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Choose a plant picture.
- 2. What is the name of the plant? Assign a **maroon** 'name' card to the image.
- Decide which part of the plant we usually eat. Assign a green 'part of the plant' card to the image.
- 4. How would you describe this part of the plant? Assign a **blue** 'description' card to the image.
- 5. Can you think of any more examples of plants like this? Assign an **orange** 'other examples' card to the image.

NAME CARDS

Broccoli Strawberry Potato Chard Carrots Pea Kohl Rabi Garlic

PART OF THE PLANT CARDS

Seed Fruit Flower Tuber Stem Leaves Bulb Root

DESCRIPTION CARDS

Plant them in soil and they will germinate into a new plant.

Often has colourful petals to attract bees for pollination.

Contains seeds.
Often sweet and tasty.

Growing underground they store food for the plant.

Usually green.
Absorbs sunlight and turns it into food for the plant.

Made up of layers. They help plants survive cold and drought.

The part of the plant above the soil. Carries water to the leaves and flowers.

Holds the plant in the soil. Absorbs water and minerals to keep the plant healthy.

HOLDS THE PLANT IN THE SOIL. ABSORBS WATER AND MINERALS TO KEEP THE PLANT HEALTHY.
