Role description

Volunteer Tree Planting Supervisors are needed to support community tree planting events. Successful applicants will:

- Lead a small group of volunteers in planting trees.
- Support and motivate other volunteers.
- Ensure safe planting in your group.
- Be an ambassador for Trees for Cities.
- Make our volunteers feel welcome and supported.

Role requirements

- Ability to communicate clearly with others.
- Experience working with diverse communities and / or age groups
- Willingness to work outdoors in rain and shine.
- A friendly and positive attitude.
- Good attention to detail.

Duration

A group of Volunteer Tree Planting Supervisors are needed to support up to 10 community tree planting events. Successful applicants are expected to support at least 2 events each. All events will take place on the weekend, 9am - 3pm, between November 2019 - April 2020. We are particularly looking for support on Saturday 23^{rd} and 30^{th} November.

Location

Community tree planting events will take place across London in several different boroughs. All will have access to toilet facilities and we will provide a free lunch and hot drinks. Each event will take place in an outdoor space, such as a park.



Trees for Cities will provide

- Training in how to plant trees
- All necessary tools and equipment
- Gloves and protective gear
- Health and safety training
- Hot drinks, refreshments and snacks
- Vegetarian lunch at each event
- Travel expenses of up to £10 a day
- Coverage when volunteering under the Trees for Cities Staff Insurance Policy
