Activity details:	<p>Activity: Planting young trees</p> <p>Background: The London Borough of Hillingdon is working in partnership with Trees for Cities to plant new young trees in the park. These trees will support habitats and food for urban wildlife and bring splashes of colour to the park throughout the seasons. We will also be planting edible fruit and nut trees such as hazel and crab apple for future generations to enjoy.</p> <p>Everyone will get a chance to plant a tree, we will provide guidance on how to plant the trees to give them the best chance of survival.</p> <p>What Trees for Cities will provide:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tools • Supervision and training • Free hot lunch and refreshments

All gloves must be washed for biosecurity measures between each of our tree planting events. You will need:	<p>Please wear layers and bring waterproofs just in case!</p> <p>Please wear strong shoes you don't mind getting muddy, like boots.</p>
Location	<p>Yeading Brook Meadows Hayes Northolt UB4 9JA</p>  <p>Northolt on the Central line is the nearest tube station to the site. Turn right out of the station, and walk to Moat Farm Road (stop D) where you can get the 90 bus toward Feltham. Get off at Grosvenor Avenue (Stop T). The journey takes approximately 11 minutes.</p> <p>Hayes & Harlington is the nearest train station to the site. You can take the 90 bus from outside the station, heading toward Northolt and getting off at The Brook House (Stop G). The journey takes about 20 minutes.</p> <p>From The Brook House bus stop head towards the Grosvenor Avenue bus stop, along Kingshill Avenue. From here cross the road and continue through the gate to the right of the playground. Follow this path until you meet the entrance to the meadow on your left. You will find us in the field.</p>

TREES FOR CITIES COVID-19 VOLUNTEER DISCLAIMER

Before attending any Trees for Cities' community tree planting workshops and events, all volunteers must read the following:

1. Do not attend any Trees for Cities event if you or a member of your household has exhibited signs of Covid-19, or if you have received a contact-tracing alert, in accordance with current government guidelines.
2. Trees for Cities staff are not responsible for ensuring volunteers maintain social distancing, but will support those who wish to social distance.
3. Trees for Cities staff will wear a mask if requested to do so. If any volunteers are not comfortable with breaching 2m social distancing whilst wearing a mask, they shall not be asked to do so.
